DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Department of Mental Health requests permission to enter into a 2026 contract with Capital Area Peer Services (CAPS) for the provision of peer advocacy and support, care line and consumer drop in center services to Albany County citizens suffering from mental illness. NYS Office of Mental Health (OMH) will provide pass through funding to Capital Area Peer Services for \$572,249. This appropriation is anticipated in the 2026 budget. There is no County share associated with this contract.
