Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

On November 10, 2021 Albany County entered into an agreement with New York State Homes and Community Renewal (HCR) regarding the acceptance of Community Development Block Grant Program funding in the amount of \$1,389,890. The funding supports a partnership with the Albany County Land Bank to rehabilitate residential buildings into affordable homeownership opportunities and expansion of mental health services in Albany County. Both projects are approximately 18-months in duration; however, at the time of award HCR was only authorized to enter into one year agreements. After discussion with HCR a 6-month extension was authorized. To date, the Land Bank has completed environmental testing, architecture and design work, and site work. Construction is anticipated in early 2023. The "mental health system enhancement" projects (marginal funding for Law Enforcement Assisted Diversion (LEAD), Programs & Services Coordinating Committee (PSCC), Mobile Outreach, Treatment, & Overdose Response (MOTOR), and Albany County Crisis Officials Responding & Diverting (ACCORD)) are also underway and are anticipated to conclude by May 2023.
