Dear Chairman Joyce:

The Department for Aging (DFA) requests legislative approval to enter into a renewal contract with Life Path (Senior Services of Albany), to provide Congregate Meal Services to older adults in Albany County and meet specific criteria as required by Albany County and NYSOFA. Life Path shall provide Congregate Meal Services to older adults at the following eight (8) locations, Westview Apartments, South Mall Towers, Ohav Shalom Apartments, Livingston School Apartments, Cohoes Senior Center, Senior Center of Watervliet, Helderberg Senior Center, Town of New Scotland, and Voorheesville. The Contractor shall serve 31,650 meals at their nine (9) congregate locations.

A Request for Proposal No. 2023-085 issued on June 29, 2023 requesting providers submit a proposal regarding Congregate Meals. There was a response to the RFP from six (6) providers. The six (6) were evaluated and rated by the department scoring committee using the following criteria:

- Full demonstrated comprehension of the Scope of Services; including but not limited to; Knowledge of food safety/sanitation regulations and nutrition standards; Current Dietary Guidelines including knowledge and compliance with USDA nutrition standards.
- Prior experience and/or equivalent training with quantity food production and service projects
- Professional qualifications, staffing, equipment, and demonstrated capabilities.
- Total proposed price.

After reviewing the proposals and rating scores the Congregate Meal proposals were awarded as follows;

1. Albany Jewish Community Center; Awarded - \$27,000.00
2. Colonie Senior Service Centers; Awarded - \$330,000.00
3. Green Island Senior Citizens; Awarded - \$56,529.00
4. Life Path (Senior Services of Albany); Awarded - \$379,800.00
5. Senior Projects of Ravena; Awarded - \$423,000.00

Total Awarded to Providers - \$ 1,216,329.00

Life Path shall provide education presentations to program participants at the congregate meal site not less than six (6) times during the contract year. Life Path shall be responsible for ensuring meals meet nutritional requirements established by the Food and Nutrition Board of the National Academy of Sciences National Research Council.

Contract Award Amount – \$379,800.00

Contract Term – 1/1/2024 – 12/31/2024

Funding Source – 6% - Federal, 57% - State, 37% - County
