#### **Justification**: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

As approved in ABL Resolution No. 424 of 2008, property located in the City of Albany, 144 Livingston Avenue Tax Map No. 65.74-4-12 was conveyed by the County of Albany to the Albany Housing Authority as part of the Arbor Hill Revitalization Plan. Specified in said resolution was a release for the right of reverter of title to be placed in the deed from the County to the Albany Housing Authority for this property.

Per this resolution, conditions were set allowing the County to release the right of reverter of title upon the Albany Housing Authority showing its investment in the property meets or exceeds the amount of the delinquent tax liens at the time of the county foreclosure.

Information was submitted as part of the request that generated Resolution No. 88 of 2021 indicating Albany Housing Authority's investment in 144 Livingston Avenue had exceeded the amount of the delinquent tax liens at the time of the county foreclosure. This reason was not stated in Resolution No. 88 of 2021 as it mistakenly indicated the "complete rehabilitation of the property" being the reason for the right of reverter of title to be released.

The Commisioner of the Department of Management and Budget is now requesting an amendment of ABL Resolution No. 88 of 2021 to help the Albany Housing Authority transfer this property in the spirt of Arbor Hill Revitalization Plan by having the right of reverter of title be released. In this regard submitted is a proposed resolution reviewed by the Department of Law, which amends resolution No. 88 of 2021.

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
