The Department of Mental Health requests permission to enter into a three year contract with Psychiatric Group of Albany (PGA) for the provision of psychiatrist and nurse practitioner mental health services to patients being served at the Albany County Department of Mental Health, ACT Team. First year contract is not to exceed \$1,988,439 in total with 0% percent increases in year two and a 3% increase in year three.
