DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Shaker Heritage Society requests authorization to accept a grant of \$102,000 awarded by the New York State Council on the Arts. The funds awarded will support improvements to our leasehold at the 1848 Meeting House. This proposed scope of work includes replacing a non-code compliant fire escape stairway, regrading and building a new ramped sidewalk to the east entrance, and building a panel to screen an HVAC system from view. Matching funds for this grant will be secured through support from private foundations and individual donors. No additional funding is requested from the County.
