Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Authorization is requested to transfer tax foreclosed property located in the City of Albany, 65 First Street (Tax Map No. 65.82-1-62) to L. Lee McCallister, Maria McCallister and Anna Huettel for the amount of the outstanding delinquent tax liability \$64,618.26.

Mr. and Mrs. McCallister who reside in the City of Albany at 69 First Street have demonstrated their benefit to the community by taking on tasks to keep up the appearance of properties within it by landscaping and installing flower gardens. Mr. and Mrs. McCallister along with Anna Huettel have indicated their plans to fully rehabilitate this historic property at 65 First Street.

This sale is in accordance with resolution No 29 of 2019, "Properties which will be discretionally conveyed by the County to individuals or entities for economic development purposes", "The amount to be paid for these properties shall be either its appraised value or outstanding delinquent tax liability (inclusive of interest, penalties and legal charges)"

After a review of all properties owned by L. Lee McCallister, Maria McCallister and Anna Huettel there are no delinquent taxes owed or any outstanding code violations on them.

As part of this sale, the following shall be the responsibility of L. Lee McCallister, Maria McCallister and Anna Huettel and is requested to be stated in the resolution:

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At the closing: All closing costs. In accordance with resolution No 29 of 2019, "The County will pro-rate any current real property taxes which are owed on the property as of the closing date". In addition, any current taxes that were paid by the County on this property will be subject to a proration of taxes also.
