I. and II. Executive Summary and Project Expenses:

Hackett Park is the central recreational space in the North Albany neighborhood, servicing a growing number of youth and families in the area. As basketball is quickly becoming the top sport of choice for our residents, this grant seeks to upgrade the basketball rims and backboards with tempered glass and new poles. Over the past few years, the City has made significant strides in upgrading and renovating the playground, including new ADA play structures, spray pad features, and removing overgrowth from the neighboring lots for clear sight lines. We believe that the continued revitalization of this valuable public space will attract a broader range of age groups while fostering accessibility and inclusivity. Your support will be instrumental in ensuring that Hackett Park Playground remains a safe and enjoyable place for all members of our community.

New Tempered Glass Backboards & Poles: Installing new backboards not only improves the look of the courts, but also reduces noise and increases functionality for players. In an effort to modernize our courts, the City of Albany has begun replacing our city's basketball courts with new tempered glass and rims. The cushioned 0.5-inch tempered glass includes regulation border and shooters squares fired into the glass for ease of use; built-in goal leveling features that ensure perfect rim leveling; and a durable design that can withstand players hanging on the rim. By fostering social bonds and promoting physical activity, the new rims will encourage friendly competition and community engagement, in addition to meeting tournament standards.

<u>Pads & Parts:</u> The purchase of the new rims would not include the safety pads and parts that are not included in the quote. These parts are imperative for the safety and protection of the equipment and most importantly our patrons.

<u>Senior Fitness Equipment:</u> Created for our age 55+ population, the Balance Board helps residents practice quick adjustments to horizontal ground movements, while the Assisted Step practices stepping up to make sure they can handle steps and stairs anywhere.

By supporting this grant, you will help revitalize Hackett Park Playground into an even more vibrant public space that will be cherished by the residents of Albany for years to come. Enhancing the courts playability will foster a stronger sense of well-being and belonging within the community. We eagerly anticipate your partnership in bringing this vision to life.

III. Benefits Statement

- 4. **Improving Community Engagement:** The continued revitalization of Hackett Park will make it a more vibrant and attractive public space, fostering a sense of belonging and well-being among residents, and encouraging community participation in recreational activities.
