**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE
DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
REGARDING THE 2023 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PERFORMANCE
GRANT AND AMENDING THE 2023 SHERIFF'S OFFICE BUDGET**

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding 2023 Emergency Management Performance Grant funding in an amount of \$115,836 for a term commencing October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2025, and

WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has indicated that the aforementioned grant funds will be utilized to pay for equipment, supplies and preparedness items used in the Sheriff's Office's ongoing emergency management activities and provide equipment for the new Emergency Operations Center, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has also requested a budget amendment to incorporate the aforementioned funding into the 2023 Sheriff's Office Budget, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding 2023 Emergency Management Performance Grant funding in an amount of \$115,836 for a term commencing October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2025, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2023 Sheriff's Office Budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3110 0 3305 Civil Defense by \$115,836

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.2 by \$110,000 by increasing Line Item A3110 2 2750 Security Equipment by \$110,000

Increase Appropriation Account A3110.4 by \$5,836 by increasing Line Item A3110 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$5,836

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
