I am pleased to announce that Albany County has been awarded \$50,000 in federal funding under the FY2022 Technical Rescue & Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Grant Program. Funding for this initiative is provided by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security's (DHS) State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) and is administered by the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES).
