DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

ACDSS must support 'Code Blue' regulations regarding housing individuals and families experiencing homelessness during extreme winter weather regardless of circumstance or eligibility status. Therefore, permission is requested to renew a contract with The Altamont Program to operate a Warming Center to meet mandated emergency measures and provide a low-barrier shelter option to augment existing homeless program(s) during the winter months. The Warming Station, located at 45 South Ferry Street, can serve up to 25 individuals.

A 'Code Blue' alert is called when temperatures are expected to fall below 32°F (with wind chill) for at least two consecutive hours, based on the local forecast issued by the National Weather Service for the city, town, or village within the district known to have the largest population of unsheltered homeless persons. The Warming Center will provide temporary respite shelter in such circumstances - with the approval of ACDSS.

The Warming Center will operate from 7:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m., seven days per week during Code Blue Season (November 1st through April 30th) and will serve single male and female adults 18 years and older who present as homeless and are unable or unwilling to engage with established shelter services through the Albany County Department of Social Services or who experience difficulty finding accommodations within the established shelter system (shelter or motel) due to past or potential circumstances, most often related to mental health or substance use.

During the 2024-2025 Code Blue Season, a total of 307 Albany residents were served.
