<u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Office of the Albany County District Attorney seeks to balance a negative budget line for Overtime (19900) in the amount of \$39,614.89. We are looking to correct that overage by moving \$25,000 from Temporary Help (9970) and \$30,000 from the Discovery Grant Overtime line (19900D) to the Overtime line (19900). This totals \$55,000 and should cover overtime expenses through the end of the year.

We have also been presented with an opportunity from the Unified Court System (UCS) to upgrade the four main courtrooms in the Judicial Center, the Grand Jury Room, Jury Deliberation rooms, and the Jury Assembly room. Albany County's contribution would be \$50,000 per courtroom for a total of \$250,000 at most. This investment is the intended purpose for the transferring of various unused funds into our computer equipment budget line. A separate RLA has been submitted for authorization to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with UCS towards this end.

UCS will be investing far more money per courtroom than we will be and they will also provide all installation and support for the equipment that is installed. With UCS handling installation, support, replacements, and coordination, our dollars go further. Their significant per courtroom investment, combined with our contribution, allows for a complete and future proof modernization.

Technology is transforming our justice system, and an investment today will secure Albany County's courts for the future. By contributing to the Unified Court System's technological upgrade program, the District Attorney's office capitalizes on a unique opportunity to enhance justice system interoperability to benefit all stakeholders. Our reasonable contribution, coupled with UCS's major investment, allows the installation of cutting-edge infrastructure for presenting digital evidence in our courtrooms. This equips our county to meet the exponential growth in technological evidence that the pursuit of justice now demands. The benefits are immense - seamless collaboration between the DA, Public Defender, Court Judges, and Commissioner of Jurors to achieve more equitable outcomes. Most importantly, it brings our courts into the 21st century for the people we serve. We have a responsibility to leverage partnerships that provide superior access and engagement with justice proceedings.

The program dollars from the Office of the Albany County District Attorney is a fraction of UCS's fiscal commitment. This unique opportunity presents itself at a time when this office is in the midst of long-term planning for upgrades to keep up with the exponential growth of technological evidence and the demands and expectations of the public for seamless access.
