 - Develop an implementation- ready SDOH accelerator plan to reduce disparities in health outcomes related to chronic disease in a community.








Grant Overview


- One year planning grant

SDoH Domains



Built Environment

Human-made surroundings that influence overall community health and people's behaviors that drive health.



Community-Clinical Linkages

Connections made between health care, public health, and community organizations to improve population health.



Food and Nutrition Security

Having reliable access to enough highquality food to avoid hunger and stay healthy.



Social Connectedness

When people or groups have relationships that create a sense of belonging and being cared for, valued, and supported.




Tobacco-Free Policy

Grant Requirements:

Evaluation and Performance Measurement

CDC will collaborate with recipients to:

- Monitor strategy implementation
- Assess progress toward achieving Short-term Outcomes

Short-term Outcomes

Increased collaboration and engagement across multisectoral partners

Completed implementation ready SDOH Accelerator Plan

Required Performance Measures:

Grant Requirements: Convene & Coordinate Leadership Team of multisectoral partners

At least two (2) community/catchment area/tribal members that understand the distinct characteristics and culture of the selected population(s).

A minimum of five (5) representatives from different sectors (e.g., health, housing, transportation) with the expertise and authority needed to accomplish the development of the implementation-ready SDOH Accelerator Plan in the selected SDOH priority areas.





Addressing SDoH: Role Opportunities



Convener

Foster sustainable multisectoral, multi-level partnerships



Integrator

Collect data, evaluate to build the evidence base and determine outcomes, and translate ideas across systems



Influencer

Lead approaches to develop upstream policies and solutions; direct funding to implement and scale up priority actions



Change-Maker

Generate solutions, take action, and collaborate with others to implement activities
