## <u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Assigned Counsel Program has the responsibility of providing training and developmental resources to the Panel Attorneys within the program as an obligation of our Statewide Funding. Such services are often costly to fund and initiate as an individual concern. All of our fellow counties in the Capital Region have similar responsibilities and obligations, and thus they are ideal partners to collaborate with in providing these services. This MOU would give the Albany County Assigned Counsel Program the ability to partner with Schenectady, Warren, and Saratoga County in order to present MCLE or other resource programs together through the use of Statewide Funds. This MOU merely authorizes the collaboration to work together-any expenditures would remain subject to the ordinary budgetary processes. Practically, this MOU mirrors similar collaborations such as the Stormwater Coalition.
