Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Albany County Department of Health (ACDOH) requests authorization to enter into a contract with the NYSDOH for the Drinking Water Enhancement Grant Program. This is a five-year grant, from April 1, 2020 to March 31, 2025. ACDOH requests authorization to enter into five one-year contracts - the duration of the grant period.

This grant partially funds Albany County's mandate to oversee federal and state regulations covering public drinking water systems. All revenues and expenditures were anticipated and included in the 2023 Health Department budget. These grant funds are provided to the County on an annual basis and it is not required to apply for the funding.
