DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Requesting authorization to enter into an inter-municipal agreement with the Village of Voorheesville as part of the Albany County's Municipal Park Improvement Initiative Grant Program. This county-wide initiative is for the development of parks, playgrounds, and recreational facilities throughout the County to help improve the lives of the residents and visitors. Only incorporated cities, towns, or villages within Albany County were eligible to apply. The County has agreed to provide them with a grant of \$10,600 for work to improve Pine Street Park and Nicholas Park.
