The attached correspondence is forwarded for presentation to the Albany County Legislature.



The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program is the primary provider of federal criminal justice funding to states and units of local government. Through this opportunity, the Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) will award JAG Program funds to eligible units of local government as described in the solicitation.

Note: BJA will issue a separate solicitation for states.

Listed below are all jurisdictions in the state that are eligible for FY 2021 JAG funding, as determined by the JAG formula.
