I have reviewed the documentation provided for the referenced project as it relates to State Environmental Quality Review (SEQR). This project includes the design of improvements at the upper camp at Lawson Lake County Park, which may include upgrades to the electrical system, plumbing, drinking water supply and wastewater removal systems.

As described above, the design activities associated with this project meet the criteria established for SEQR Type II actions pursuant to 6 NYCRR 617.5(c)(24)(27). Accordingly, this action has been determined not to have a significant impact on the environment, and as such, no procedural compliance with SEQR beyond this determination is required at this time.

It is important to note that the construction phase of this project must be reviewed separately under SEQR once the design alternative is chosen.
