Listed below are the documents needed to open your contract. **These must be submitted to OPDV via email (enoughisenough@opdv.ny.gov) by June 5, 2026, for the contract to be timely built and executed:**

- **Expenditure Based Budget Template**
 - The Expenditure Based Budget can be found in the attachments to this letter. Details on allowable expenses are also listed in attachments.
- **Sexual Harassment Prevention Certification**
 - Submit a completed Sexual Harassment Prevention Certification.
- 1) **Gender-Based Violence and the Workplace Certification**
 - 2) Submit a completed Gender-Based Violence and the Workplace Certification or a signed justification detailing the reasons why the certification cannot be made. Given the purpose of these grants and the role of your agency, it is expected that

all awarded programs will have GBV workplace policies in place in alignment with State Finance Law 139-m.

3) **Advance Request Form**

- 4) Advance requests of up to 25% of the annual contract amount are available. Awarded programs must submit this form by **06/05/2026**. Once the contract is approved, we will process the advanced payment.

5) **For grantees that do not provide services to victims/survivors of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, stalking and/or technology-facilitated gender-based violence or do not offer these services using EIE grant funds:**

A plan to meet these needs must be submitted to OPDV for review and approval prior to contract execution. Please refer to the EIE Contract Guidelines for further information.

In addition, program-specific versions of the following forms must also be submitted via email (enoughisenough@opdv.ny.gov) to execute your contract. **These must also be received by June 5, 2026:**

- 6) Proof of current Worker's Compensation Insurance with OPDV as the Certificate Holder
- 7) Proof of current Disability Insurance with OPDV as the Certificate Holder (Must be submitted on form DB 120.1. Information about obtaining the proper form can be found [here](#).)
- 8) All awardees are required to be registered in the NYS Statewide Financial System (SFS) as a vendor. **If you are not already registered in SFS**, directions can be found [here](#). If you do not currently have a Statewide Financial System (SFS) Log-in, please contact the SFS Helpdesk at 518-457-7737, 877-737-4185 or HelpDesk@sfs.ny.gov immediately to start the process of gaining access.
- 9) A Vendor Responsibility profile with a certified date no later than February 1, 2026. If you do not currently have a Vendor Responsibility profile, please click [here](#).
- 10) Current Charities Registration with the Charities Bureau, if applicable.
