This project would include a Hardware and Consulting Services procurement to replace Albany County's Primary and Backup Internet firewalls along with the Primary and backup segmentation firewalls. The project would include the procurement of 4 new Next Generation Firewalls (NGFW) to replace legacy hardware that is currently in place. Additionally this project will include consulting services to help in facilitating an network redesign that would improve the County's Cyber Security posture while also improving infrastructure speed and reliability.
