SPECIAL PROJECT COORDINATOR (BROADBAND)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS:</u> The incumbent in this position does specialized project management in the research, development and deployment of broadband infrastructure in Albany County. Through the implementation of Albany County's 2022 Broadband Plan, the incumbent will perform a variety of functions including identifying, securing and maintaining grant funds, coordination with municipalities, community stakeholders, and private organizations, and identification of underserved areas and populations of Albany County. Work is performed under the supervision of the Chief Information Officer with wide leeway in decision making. Does related work as required.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

- Lead the implementation of the County's 2022 Broadband Plan including pursuing broadband infrastructure development and digital equity focused programming;
- Identify and implement new programs, policies, and interventions aimed to close the digital equity divide;
- Assess external funding opportunities for broadband infrastructure development, broadband programs and services, promotion of digital equity, and associated work with partners, develop and pursue a prioritized list of funding opportunities:
- In coordination with the Office of the County Executive, administer the process for utilizing county, state, and federal resources to expand broadband access;
- Work with broadband providers including local utilities and private Internet Service Providers to identify funding and launch infrastructure development projects to bring broadband to underserved areas;
- Identify broadband specific performance metrics and create a system to track local progress towards goals achievement:
- Recommends changes to policy and procedure to facilitate the implementation and expansion of broadband infrastructure;
- Lead broadband-focused partnership opportunities with partners including local municipalities, community-based organizations, libraries, educational institutions, and private companies;
- Coordinate County broadband efforts with the efforts of the County's Towns, Cities, and Villages.
- Convene and manage groups through communications, meeting facilitation, and solicitation of local resources.
- · Represent Albany County at broadband stakeholder groups;
- Collaborate with economic development entities and identify opportunities to leverage ongoing initiatives;
- Provide other administrative and support services for the Division of Information Services as assigned, including assistance with developing new systems, processes, and policies;
- Does related work as required.
