# **DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Due to the continued volatility in the natural gas market the County's natural gas supplier Direct Energy/NRG is recommending locking in the basis cost for the County's daily and monthly natural gas accounts. The remaining supply cost will be purchased in blocks over the next year. This approach will allow the County to take advantage of dips in gas pricing and dollar cost average the supply charges over the course of the next year.
