### **<u>DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:</u>** (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

New York State Legislation raised the age of Juvenile Delinquency to 16 and 17-year-old children. Raise the age legislation was first enacted on October 1,2018 for 16-year-old and October 1,2019 for 17-year-old. It also created a new class of Offender called Adolescent Offender. This was any 16 or 17-year-old being charged with a felony. Adolescent Offenders charged with all but the most serious felonies will automatically have their case removed to Family Court after 30 days unless there is a written objection by the District Attorney. Voluntary probation services tailored for youth will be available for Adolescent and Juvenile Offenders. Youth in Adolescent Court will no longer be sentenced or detained in a facility with adults. The Probation Department is mandated to provide programs and supervision to raise The Age Youth.
