

RESOLUTION NO. 286

**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH TRINITY ALLIANCE OF THE
CAPITAL REGION, INC. REGARDING THE PROVISION OF FAMILY AND
NEIGHBORHOOD RESOURCE CENTER SERVICES**

By Social Services Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Albany County Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with Trinity Alliance of the Capital Region, Inc. regarding the provision of Family and Neighborhood Resource Center (FNRC) services for the term commencing October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$170,000, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has indicated that the funding, which requires a 30.5% County match, will be used to provide family stabilization through the provision of family strengthening primary, secondary and tertiary preventive measures, all aimed at preventing placement of children in foster care, mental health hospitalization and/or criminal justice involvement, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has further indicated the FNRC provides reunification support for families with individuals returning from incarceration or residential treatment, and the vast majority of over five hundred monthly consumers of the programming services are African-American, Latino/Hispanic, and from immigrant populations including Butanese, Burmese, and Iraqi, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with Trinity Alliance of the Capital Region, Inc., Albany, NY 12202 regarding the provision of Family and Neighborhood Resource Center Services for the term commencing October 1, 2021 and ending September 30, 2022 in an amount not to exceed \$170,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
