DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Albany County Department of Parks and Recreation is seeking permission to accept \$50,000 in funding for the NY SWIMS Lifeguard Grant Program. This Grant Program addresses a critical shortage of staff lifeguards, including those contracted through third parties or contracted lifeguards, available at public locations such as pools and beaches in New York State municipalities. Albany County will work with its municipalities to identify public swimming locations and outline how funding will be used to increase the number of staff and contracted lifeguards or expand operating hours.
