The involvement of individuals with lived experience in the recovery journey of those facing Behavioral Health Challenges can be a significant factor in supporting successful outcomes. However, due to ongoing workforce shortages, it can be very difficult to recruit and retain individuals for these much-needed positions. We believe that providing retention incentives and increased access to training opportunities will support the growth and sustainability of the Peer Workforce in Mental Health.
