**DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:** (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

To accept the Go-Go Grandparent grant funding from New York State Office for Aging. This grant funding will support an initiative for on demand transportation for older adults residing in Albany County through a platform/application called Go-Go Grandparent. This transportation service will complement Department for Aging's existing vital transportation services through Access Transit, Inc., by offering non-medical/essential transportation. The platform/application will be connected to providers such as Lyft, Uber and other local transport offerings for older adults in need of this type of transportation. The grant funding supports a performance based program, which will determine the sustainability of the program. The need and usage throughout the year will be data collected through Go-Go Grandparent's database and will show the need for this type of transportation for future funding. This grant will offer an estimated 2500 additional non-medical /essential transportation units the Department for Aging will offer to older adults residing in Albany County.
