#### **Justification**: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Department of General Services requests authorization to enter into an agreement with Ritter & Paratore Contracting, Inc. pursuant to RFB 2022-024 Demolition of the Structures at #875 Albany Shaker Road. The base bid of \$1,584,000 plus a 10% contingency allowance of \$158,400.00 and an electric service relocation allowance of \$ 135,000.00 for a not to exceed \$1,877,400.00.

The Ann Lee Nursing Home facility has outlived it useful life and is currently sitting vacant on property adjacent to the Albany International Airport. Rehabilitation of the facility has become prohibitively expensive and would limit future use of the facility to the current building footprint. Consistent with the County's initiatives to identify shovel ready sites and promote economic development, the demolition of the facility would allow the County to redevelop the property.

All cost of these services will be covered under bond number HHYZ Res. No. 518 of 2019 adopted November 12, 2019. SEQR and SHPO reviews have been completed with documentation attached.

The term of this contract will commence upon signing and continue until the project is completed and signed off by the Department of General Services. Projected term is May 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023

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
