<u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

In April, 2017, New York State passed legislation raising the age of criminal responsibility to 18-years old in an effort to provide young people in New York with intervention and evidenced based treatment they need. The new measure was phased in over time, raising the age of criminal responsibility from 16 to 17-years old beginning October 1, 2018, and subsequently raising the age to 18-years old on October 1, 2019. Evidence based services are mandated to be provided to RTA Youth. DCYF has entered into a contract with Cayuga Centers to provide Juvenile Justice Prevention services for Multisystem Therapy. Multisystem Therapy is an intense, family-focused and community-based treatment program for juveniles with serious criminal offenses who are possibly abusing substances. It is a therapy strategy to teach families success. We would like to enter into an interdepartmental agreement with DCYF to provide this service to Probation Raise the Age Youth and their families.
