DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Office of the County Executive is requesting to amend the termination date and extend the period of performance of an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services regarding the Albany County Hazard Mitigation Plan through 3/31/26. The final submission of the County Hazard Mitigation Plan was delayed due to an unforeseen requirement of the planning process. The plan has since been fully submitted but the extension is required to meet DHSES and FEMA standards. This is a no cost extension.
