## Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The County of Albany has been awarded \$100,000 by the Capital District Planning Commission as part of their 023-2024 Unified Planning Work Program for the Broadway Flood Resilient Multi-Modal Corridor Study. The project concept was identified during the development of the Albany County Climate Resiliency Plan and will identify and evaluate conceptual design alternatives that improve multi-modal transportation facilities and connectivity, increase the urban forest, and integrate green infrastructure and climate resiliency along the length of the Broadway/Route 32 corridor from Albany to Watervliet. The study will complement several ongoing planning efforts including upcoming studies focused on 787 and the Troy Menands Bridge. The County committed to provide a \$10,000 cash match and CDTC will provide an additional \$30,000 in technical assistance. Executing the attached MOU is the first step necessary to advance this project.
