WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Children, Youth and Families has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with New York State's designated Home Health Entity, Children's Health Home of Upstate New York (CHHUNY), regarding reimbursement for all Medicaid Care Management Services provided to children in Albany County for the term commencing January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated while this is a Medicaid initiative, it remains the responsibility of the County legacy Targeted Case Management Services program to provide services to non-Medicaid children as well, which will continue to be funded by New York State Office of Mental Health State Aid funding, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with New York State's designated Home Health Entity, CHHUNY, regarding reimbursement for all Medicaid Care Management Services provided to children in Albany County for the term commencing January 1, 2019, and ending December 31, 2019, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
