<u>DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:</u> (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Department of General Services requests Legislative authorization to exercise the second period of the current five (5) year contract, Resolution 164 of 2024, with the New York State Unified Court System Third Judicial District in accordance with the terms of Chapter 686 of the Laws of 1996.

This authorization will cover services provided from April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025 and provide reimbursements totaling \$823,326.00 as detailed in Appendix B of the proposed agreement.

Further Legislative authorization will be required for each successive annual reimbursement.
