The Department of Mental Health respectfully requests permission to award \$262,900 in Opioid Settlement Funding to Addiction Care Centers of Albany (ACCA) for the purpose of providing school-based substance use prevention services at three Albany County middle schools: Voorheesville, Berne-Knox-Westerlo and the Albany Leadership Academy.
