The Department of Mental Health requests permission for a contract renewal with Information Management Associates (IMA). The contract is for the ongoing subscription and license agreement for operation of patient and billing software that includes web-based access for clinicians, patient portal access, billing modules, e-signature capabilities, NYS Clinical Records Initiative compliance and use of e-prescribing and expansion of Mental Health's EHR (Electronic Health Record) system. The 2025 contract is for \$116,436 an increase of \$2,466 from 2024.
