Dear Mr. Joyce:

The attached correspondence is forwarded for presentation to the Albany County Legislature.

Legislative approval is required in order to allow Albany County to apply for and accept a grant with the State of New York, Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, as a recipient of a 2022-2023 Hazardous Materials Emergency Preparedness grant. Albany County is acting as fiduciary for the Capital Region Hazmat Group. The participating counties are Albany, Rensselaer, Saratoga and Schenectady Counties.

The grant award is for \$16,000.00. These grant funds will be utilized to cover expenses related to training and equipment related to the transportation of hazardous materials. The funds will be used to convert a tank trailer (similar to those used to transport gasoline) into a leak simulator. The trailer was donated to the Watervliet Arsenal Fire Department. The grant is non-competitive and each of the 18 Hazmat regions in the state are receiving the same amount.

The FY2022-23 HMEP period of performance is from June 1, 2023 - December 31, 2024.

We propose to use an existing fairmable legal tank trader (DOT Type 406) and convert it atto a leak simulator similar to the one that OFPC uses at the State Fire Academy. The trader will be received through a donatum and the value of the trader will be used as the grant malch. Pictures of the existing braier and of a leak simulator similar to what we propose to produce are attached in separate tabs in the workbook. The traiter will be used for training hazinat teams and other firefighters during his produce and the annual hazinat training season / exercise, Hazinat training modules 3, 4 and 5 are usually offered each year in September and the annual exercise is normally held in April or Maly, it is our highly to have the baller ready for the April 2024 around sercises. The training and exercises usually take place at the Waterviet Arsenal but we hope to make the traiter usudworthy so it can be taken anywhere in the 4 county region for training. The Albany County Sherif's Office has the tractior portion of a tractor trader that can be used to move the trader.

Per CEPA, the Capital Region is susceptible to a variety of natural, accidental/technological and man-made/intentional hazards, Based on the likelihood and consequence analysis, the hazarids posing the most insk include. Flooding Severe Winter Snowdourns, Ice Storms, Cyber Altack, Haz-Mat Release and Haz-Mat Release - In-Transit. The area is the crossitudes of Intensiales 97 & 90, it is also home to the Sekirk Rad Yard, the busiest rail yard this sube of Chicago.

Training classes include OFPC Hazmat Modules 3, 4 and 5, No money is being used for instructions, etc. Currently, there are not ut see load learns unablable for training in upstate New York. Having a simulator locately wall down us to perform training for the members of the various hazmat learns is well as firefighters from the career departments at a significant savings. Currently, such training requires overinght travel to the State Fire Academy of to facilities outside New York State. We expect to see the baller at the Agid, 2024 annual framing session (Peccricia).


