Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Albany County Dept of Health (ACDOH) is requesting authorization to accept additional funding in the amount of \$19,159 from NYS DOH Bureau of TB Control (BTBC). The supplemental funding will be used to support the Ukrainian Refugee population in Albany County. The ACDOH will collaborate with the Refugee Health Program to provide tuberculosis services to identified Ukrainian newcomers. The funding will support the following TB services: outreach, testing, evaluation and clinic services.

We request approval to accept the additional funding of \$19,159; to amend the total grant amount in the 2023 Health Department Budget by \$19,159 from \$46,498 to \$65,657; and to enter into a contract amendment with NYS DOH BTBC.
