Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The County Executive's Office, on behalf of the Department of Health and Division of Information Services, respectfully requests legislative authorization to enter into a no cost extension of the NYS Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Services' FY2018 State Homeland Security Program (SHSP) grant. This grant originally ended on August 31, 2021, however there was approximately \$50,000 unspent as of this date, out of a \$452,000 award. The delay in spending by the end of the grant's period of performance is directly attributable to the COVID-19 pandemic as the Health Department was forced to shift priorities and engage in an all-hands effort to respond to the pandemic. Recognizing that COVID-19 played an outsized role in the Health Department's delay in implementing some of its planned preparedness initiatives, the NYS Division of Homeland Security & Emergency Services has offered a 1 year nocost extension on the grant period until 8/31/2022. The total award amount remains unchanged, and the grant was previously anticipated in County budget cycles.
