Supplemental Agreement No. 3 – Additional Construction Inspection Services

Ms. Ramundo,

M. J. Engineering and Land Surveying, P.C. (MJ) is submitting this Supplemental Agreement for additional funding for the above referenced contract. The following information represents MJ's understanding of the additional funding requested.

BACKGROUND

Based on the overall project schedule, the 2022 construction season was slated for tree removal and utility relocation work and the 2023 construction season was for the main roadway construction. The existing overhead utility lines needed to be completely relocated for the main line roadway work to be completed. See below, a timeline of events that occurred which has led to the contractor submitting a delay claim. This claim is due to overhead utilities not being relocated in a timely manner to complete the project by the original completion date of November 30, 2023. The County has granted a contract extension to the contractor.

- November 2022 Tree Clearing contract completed.
- December 2022 National Grid completed relocation of utility poles along mainline.
- o January 2023 National Grid Completed relocation of overhead electric lines along mainline.
- March 2023 National Grid's subcontractor completed gas line relocation.
- o April 26, 2023 Notice to Proceed given to the contractor.
- May 2, 2023 Contractor first day of work.
- May 16, 2023 Contractor requested contract time extension.
- July 11, 2023 Contractor submitted formal delay claim letter.
- July 20, 2023 Meeting held to discuss remaining overhead utility lines to be relocated.
- August 4, 2023- Signal poles removed at Vly & Career Path to expedite relocation process.
- October 3, 2023 All overhead utility lines are relocated.
- October 4, 2024 All utility poles along mainline are relocated.









Based on the efforts expensed by MJ to date, the current construction inspection budget will be exhausted within a few weeks once the contractor is back on site in April. To support the anticipated construction activities in the 2024 Construction season, the attached staffing estimate has been developed.

ASSUMPTIONS AND TASKS NOT INCLUDED IN THIS PROPOSAL

This Supplemental effort has been prepared assuming the following:

- 1. Staff will include one full-time Resident Engineer (RE).
- 2. Limited night work may be required.
- 3. Weekend work may be required to address contractor work schedule.
- 4. Ten (10) hour days are anticipated.
- 5. Records will continue to be kept in accordance with the NYSDOT Manual of Uniform Recordkeeping (MURK).
- 6. Appia Software will continue to be utilized to keep records and track quantities. An Appia license renewal will be required. This will be tracked and invoiced as a direct cost.
- 7. The contractor's current construction schedule was used in developing the fee, this assumes final completion by July 31, 2024.
- 8. 80 hours of part-time services are included to final-out the project.
- 9. Record plans and final documentation will be prepared within 30 days of final completion.

SCHEDULE

The contractor's current intended construction schedule was used to develop this Supplemental Agreement. If the construction schedule is modified for any reason, it could affect the substantial completion date and overall completion of the project, ultimately affecting the assumptions made in this Supplemental Agreement.

FEE

The attached fee schedule has been developed based on the identified Scope of Work.
