Dear Chairwoman Cunningham,

The Albany County Department of Mental Health (ACDMH) respectfully requests the authorization of a budget amendment to transfer funds from the Veteran Mental Health Peer Advocate positions into the "March On" Veteran's Department Budget Line. On August 12th of 2024, the County Legislature approved resolution 24-469, amending the 2024 Department of Mental Health Budget to establish mental health peer advocate positions for veterans. This authorized two peer advocate positions with lived military experience, with an annual salary of \$46,939 per advocate. However, after trying to hire for these roles for the past weeks, we believe changing the direction of these roles will prove more beneficial for Albany County and its veteran population.

We are requesting to amend the budget for the Department of Mental Health by transferring the funds originally allocated for the peer advocate positions back into the Veteran's Department "March On" budget line. By transferring these funds, we intend to add a new veterans-based care position into the 2025 budget with a higher paying salary to better fill the position.

The remaining funds will be utilized for wrap around services for veterans, and will be divided evenly between the Veteran's Department and Mental Health Department. Wrap around services may include food, blankets, IDs, security deposits, and other supports to enhance quality of life.

DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

On August 12th of 2024, the Albany County Legislature approved resolution 24-469, amending the 2024 Department of Mental Health Budget to establish mental health peer advocate positions for veterans. This authorized two peer advocate positions with lived military experience, with an annual salary of \$46,939 per advocate. However, after trying to hire for these roles for the past weeks, we believe changing the direction of these roles will prove more beneficial for Albany County and its veteran population.

We are requesting to amend the budget for the Department of Mental Health by transferring the funds originally allocated for the peer advocate positions back into the Veteran's Department "March On" budget line.
