<u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Health Department respectfully requests approval to seek out-of-county candidates for the position of Assistant Director of Environmental Health. Given the unique specialty requirements and responsibilities attached to this position, the department has had difficulty recruiting qualified in- county candidates with requisite skills and experience.

The Health Department seeks to employ an individual with the following qualifications: A Bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university in sanitary, environmental, chemical, civil, or public health engineering or a related engineering field; or a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited or New York State registered college or university with thirty (30) credit hours in the natural sciences, of which not more than twelve (12) credit hours may be in the applied sciences; **AND**, the candidate shall possess one year of administrative and supervisory experience as a supervising engineer or supervising sanitarian, or three years of environmental health experience*, including one year of supervisory responsibility that demonstrates that the candidate has the technical and administrative skills necessary to manage programs that can anticipate, recognize and respond to environmental health challenges.

The department posted the position online and reached out to representatives of the New York State Association of County Health Officials (NYSACHO). Neither resulted in identifying qualified in-county candidates. Having the ability to consider out-of-County candidates will increase the pool of individuals with the needed skillset.
