Recognizing that drowning is the leading cause of death for children ages 1-4 and that climate change will increase extreme heat events, Governor Hochul announced the New York Statewide Investment in More Swimming (NY SWIMS) initiative, a new competitive matching Grant program to expand access to safe swimming facilities in Underserved Communities across the State. Albany County will apply for these funds to reimburse costs associated with the Cohoes Pool and related infrastructure improvements.
