RESOLVED, That Resolution No. 491 for 2022 is amended to reflect a term ending September 30, 2026 rather than September 30, 2025, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said amendment as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
