Environmental Lead investigations in dwellings in Albany County where children reside or are likely to reside or spend a significant amount of time(minimum of 8 hours per week) before they are found to have an elevated blood lead level (EBLL). Investigations include initial assessments for deterioration of lead base paint in residences located in the following zip codes: 12202, 12206, 12208, 12209 and 12210. Where lead hazards are found, this department then meets with the owner of the building (or landlord), insures appropriate remediation, conducts follow-up inspections, and performs dust wipe sampling to ensure that the remediation has been conducted properly and thoroughly. At the time of the inspection education will be given to the tenant regarding the danger of lead poisoning and how to prevent it. A "Recall logbook" (book containing toys and other items recalled by the Consumer Product Safety Commission for high lead levels) will be shown to the residence to check for items that they may have, that contain high amounts of lead. A cleaning item gift bag will be given to the tenant as an incentive to have their residence inspected and to help them maintain their dwelling free from lead dust.

## <u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Albany County Department of Health has been notified by the New York State Department of Health of a contract extension for the Childhood Lead Poisoning Primary Prevention Program. This program conducts activities and inspections to prevent lead poisoning in children before they become exposed. This grant was anticipated in the 2020 and 2021 department budget. ACDOH is requesting approval to extend the program from April 1, 2020 to September 30, 2021 in the amount of \$613,632.
