Dear Mr. Joyce

The Albany County Energy Advisory Group (EAG), acting as the County's agent to secure the purchase of low cost electric energy, is requesting a contract authorization with Direct Energy Business LLC (Direct Energy) for the supply of electric services to various County facilities as identified in the enclosed attachments. The contract term is for three years for the period of August 1, 2021 through July 31, 2024, with the option of two one year extensions.

In response to the above subject RFP, two proposals were received, the first by Direct Energy and the second by Constellation New Energy Inc. The Energy Advisory Group conducted a thorough evaluation and agreed unanimously that Direct Energy would bring the best value to the County based on the following:

- Proven experience in providing reliable and cost effective electric service to the County.
- Full understanding of the requested services and the ability to provide an actively managed Load Follow Block and Index product, that will allow the County to lock in fixed rates, for specified periods and amounts to be determined by the EAG during the contract term.
- Understanding the County's budget and legislative process and being responsive in meeting the County's changing needs.
- Providing an option to offer the County an additional 10% savings off National Grid's distribution charges via a Community Solar program.

To take advantage of the Community Solar (CS) savings, the EAG is recommending entering into a long term Community Solar agreement for the following accounts:

- 1. Correctional Facility: NG Account# 3628681106
- 2. ACWPD South Plant: NG Account# 4339937105
- 3. ACWPD North Plant: NG Account# 8039139107

Although the fixed adder charge by Direct Energy was not the lowest price, the saving potential from the three account listed above utilizing the CS program resulted in Direct Energy's proposal being the most cost effective. The CS agreement would be structured for a five renewable five years terms up to twenty five years. Based on historical usage for the above referenced accounts the CS program is estimated to save \$42,968 for the first year and \$1,257,533 over the course of 25 years.

Limiting the Community Solar agreement to the accounts listed above would also allow the County to pursue a separate in-county solar project under a separate power purchase agreement.

Enclosed for your reference is the EAG scoring worksheet, list of County accounts under this contract and cost analysis of the two proposals.

Cost Comparison

Recommendation: The Energy Advisory Board (EAB) met on 7/27/2021 to discuss the electric supply bids. Based on the County's green initiatives and the cost savings available from the Community Solar program the EAB is recommending awarding the electric supply contract to Direct Energy with inclusion of the ACWPD North Plant, South Plant and Correctional Facilty accounts into a community solar agreement.

^{1.} Direct Energy included an administrative fee for the MEGA (Municipal Electric and Gas Alliance) program in their original adder cost. As MEGA is not being used for the County's electric supply Direct Energy eliminated their MEGA fee resulting in a fixed adder rate of \$0.00894/kWh

^{2.} Direct Energy offered a Community Solar program as a value add in their proposal. As part of the bid review Constellation indicated they did not offer a Community Solar option at this time.
