Approving Previous Meeting Minutes: Unanimously approved as amended by Mr. Burgdorf.

- 1. <u>Local Law No. "G" for 2018</u>: A Local Law of the County of Albany, New York to Limit the Length of Time that Canines May be Restrained Outdoors in Any Continuous Twelve-Hour Period: Tabled at the request of the sponsor.
- 2. <u>Local Law No. "J" for 2018</u>: A Local Law of the County of Albany, New York Establishing Color Requirements for Petroleum Bulk Storage Tanks: Tabled at the request of the sponsor.
- 3. <u>Resolution No. 236</u>: Amending the Albany County Rules of Order: Tabled at the request of the sponsor.
- 4. <u>Resolution No. 238</u>: Amending the Legislative Procedures of the Albany County Legislature: Tabled at the request of the sponsor.

- 13. <u>Resolution No. 300:</u> Amending the Albany County Legislature's Rules of Order Regarding the Fiscal Impact Statement: Tabled at the Request of the Sponsor.
- 14. <u>Resolution No. 222:</u> Requiring the Submission of Amended Local Laws Prior to Legislative Action: Tabled at the request of the sponsor.
- 15. <u>Local Law No. "F" for 2018:</u> A Local Law of the County of Albany, New York Amending Local Law No. 8 for 2011 as Subsequently Amended to Implement an Anti-Nepotism Policy: After brief discussion, the Committee voted unanimously to move the proposal forward for legislative action with a negative recommendation. Mr. Crouse noted that he would have supported a motion to move the proposal forward with a favorable recommendation.
- 16. <u>Local Law No. "T" for 2019:</u> A Local Law of the County of Albany, New York to Establish Clean Air Standards for Waste Burning Facilities: After brief discussion, the Committee voted on a motion to table the proposal which failed on a 3-3 vote, with Chairperson Plotsky, Messrs. Peter and Touchette opposed. The Committee then voted 5-1, with Mr. Crouse opposed, to move the proposal forward for legislative action without recommendation.
- 17. Amending the Rules and Regulations for Albany County Regarding the Hiring of Relatives: After brief discussion, the Committee voted 5-1, with Mr. Crouse opposed, to move the proposal forward for legislative action with a favorable recommendation.
- 18. Authorizing an Agreement with the New York State Office of Indigent Legal Services Regarding an Extension of the Counsel at First Appearance Grant: The Albany County Public Defender requested authorization to extend the term of the Counsel at First Appearance Grant through May 31, 2020. After brief discussion, the Committee voted unanimously to move the proposal forward for legislative action with a favorable recommendation.
