DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Shaker Heritage Society requests authorization to undertake capital improvements to the 1825 Ministry Building on our leasehold. The proposed scope of work includes removing the decayed metal roof and tarps currently in place and replacement with a new standing seam metal roof to match those installed on the Brethren's and Trustees' buildings in 2022. This work will be funded through a pledge of private foundation funds. No additional funding is requested from the County. A project estimate, detailed aerial images, and technical specifications are enclosed for legislative review. This project will additionally be submitted to the State Historic Preservation Office for Covenant Review and approval before any work commences.
