#### **Justification**: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Albany County Department of Social Services is seeking contract authorization with CARES of NY Inc. to address unsheltered homelessness in the City of Albany and the County of Albany by connecting unsheltered individuals with substance abuse treatment, mental health treatment, and housing assistance. The Department of Social Services seeks to bring services directly to place unsheltered persons spend their time, including but not limited to breakfast programs, warming centers, on the street, and other locations. The program will serve all parts of Albany County, with particular focus on South Pearl Street, Lark Street, Henry Johnson Blvd., and the Central Avenue Corridor of the City of Albany.

CARES of NY, Inc. will be providing a program of addressing homelessness through the connection of housing resources and mental health programs. Albany County will provide \$300,000 annually over a three-year period, with matching funding from the City of Albany for this program, for a combined \$600,000 annually over a three-year period.

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
