**Re: Approval of Water Purification District Capital Projects in compliance with EFC and
New York State Consolidated Law Article 5A**

Dear Chairwoman Cunningham,

The Albany County Water Purification District (District) is requesting Legislative approval of the District's Capital Projects as listed below and as previously adopted by the Legislature under the 2025-2029 and subsequent 2026-2030 Albany County Capital Program and as presented at the County Public Hearing that will be held on August 26, 2025.

- Sludge Processing Improvement Project
- North Plant Treatment Process Improvements
- South Plant Treatment Process Improvements
- North and South Plant HVAC Upgrades

The approval of the above referenced capital projects shall be based on the following criteria:

1. The District facility improvements identified under the adopted Capital Program were determined to be in the public interest.
2. The District facility improvements identified under the adopted Capital Program were determined to be approved pursuant to Article 5A, Section 268 of the New York Consolidated Law.
3. The estimated annual debt service obligations for the proposed facility improvements identified under the adopted Capital Program do not constitute an undue burden to a typical property that would bear the cost of said improvements as defined by the New York State Comptroller.

4. The proposed facility improvements would not require a separate review by the New State Comptroller, as the cost of said improvements was determined not to constitute an undue burden to a typical property.
5. The estimated annual debt service obligation will be borne by the eight member municipalities that comprise the District in accordance with the original municipal agreements that were executed as part of the District formation.

Enclosed with this request is a copy of the District's 2025-2029 and 2026-2030 Capital Programs that were previously adopted via Legislative Resolution 212 of 2024 and Resolution 229 of 2025 respectively. The aforementioned resolutions and the debt service estimate for the proposed projects outlined the Capital Program are also attached for your reference.
