The Albany County Department of Mental Health (ACDMH) is seeking permission to apply for the Solutions to End Homelessness Program (STEHP) 2024-2027 Grant from the New York State (NYS) Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA), totaling \$1,175,000. This grant will enable us to expand services to underserved populations, specifically addressing the mental health needs of homeless individuals through the development of a Street Psychiatry Program. This grant offers a timely opportunity to deliver mental health care directly to individuals living on the streets, in parks, under bridges, or other community-based locations where homeless individuals are situated. Through community-based delivery of mental health and addiction treatment, the program will help overcome barriers to accessing care through traditional routes.
